Dubay, Robert Vincent 93 Sept. 02, 1921 Aug. 22, 2015 Robert "Bob" Vincent Dubay was born Sept. 2, 1921, in Minneapolis, to Alfred and Alice (Abel) Dubay. He was raised on the family farm with his six sisters and three brothers. He served his country during WWII as a flight officer and advanced instructor in the U.S. Army Air Corps. Following his service in the military, Bob worked for the Interstate Commerce Commission as a district director until his retirement in 1973. Bob then went on to build a new business, Steelcraft Distributing, with his close friend, Dennis DeHaas. Bob was creative, driven, loving, fair and had a brilliant mind with near perfect recall for anything he had read. He was always the first person to cry when told a sad story and always the first person to laugh heartily at a good joke. Bob was a "Plankowner" and volunteer with the Save the P.T. Boat Foundation, restoring the nation's only fully operational PT boat. He also spent time re-building and flying antique Stearman Aircraft with the "Fern Prairie Air Force" in Camas, Wash. Bob was preceded in death by his parents, Alfred Alexander Dubay and Alice Ann (Abel) Dubay; son, John Dubay and daughter-in-law, Ann; sisters, Bernice "Bea," Virginia "Ginny," Jocelyn, Jacqueline and Lorraine "Leigh"; and brothers, Leonard, Fred and Paul. He is survived by his loving wife, Monica Helen (McCann) Dubay; sister, Gloria "Gigi" Mitchell; children, Robert (Samantha) Dubay, Daniel (Lynn) Dubay, Jeanine (Jim) Cavagnaro and Ronald (Sherri) Dubay; and grandchildren, Ryan Alexander Dubay and Maria Pearl Cavagnaro.
